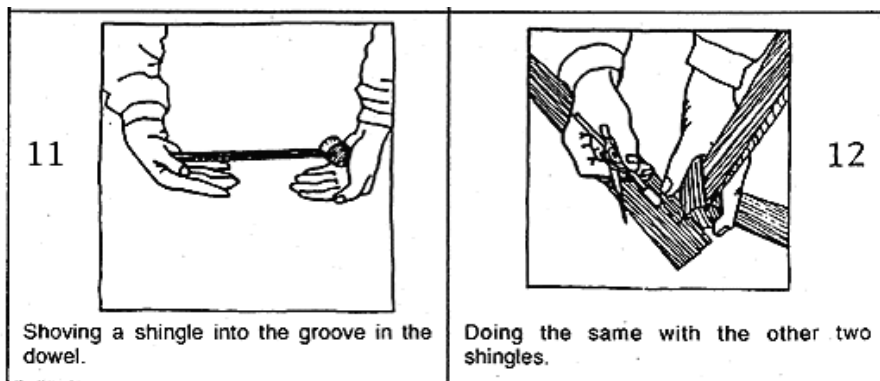

A small amount of money for ice cream or something in the surrounding stores.

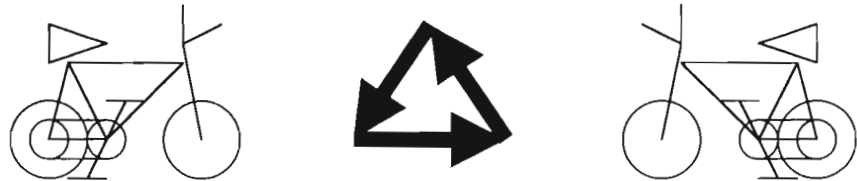
## Meeting Place:

Monday we will be going to the WELLESLEY RECYCLING CENTER!! YAY!

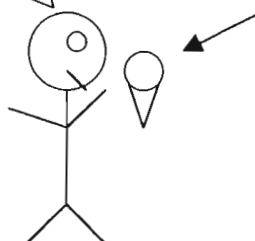

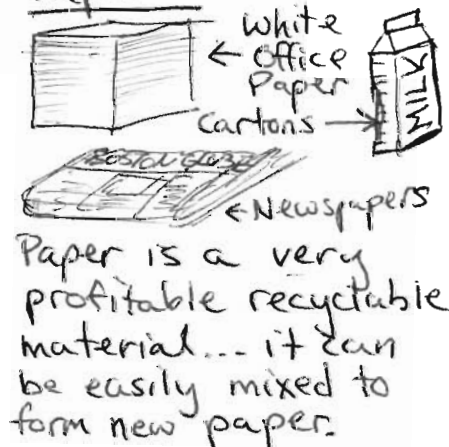
